molestation whatsoever, but on the contrary upon  
the said Ship, if they happen to touch in any of  
any of Our Subjects that have been in France  
also that the said Ship do not carry any Army  
Bullets, Pitch, Tarr, Hemp, Masts, Cordage, Iron  
of War to any Port or Place belonging to the  
foremer to Goods and Merchandises; And  
Voyage only and no longer; Given at Our  
1709. in the Eighth Year of Our Reiz



Part for the Spanish Ship St. Juan to go from St. Sebastian to the Coast

of Great Britain France and Ireland Defender of the Faith &c. To  
Commanders of Our Ships of War or Privateers, Governours of Our Ports  
and to all and singular Our Officers Civil and Military, Our Ministers  
Wishing Our Will and Pleasure is, and We do hereby strictly charge  
and desire the Officers and Ministers of all Princes and States in Unity  
Our Ship *San Juan* Ourthon Three Hundred Tuns and carrying  
men whereof Captain Santiago de Anzoreguy is Commander laden  
with other Goods not prohibited or Contraband to sail from the Port of *St. Sebastian*  
for *Whale* and to return from thence to the said Port of *St. Sebastian*  
with other the Product of their said fishery without any Let, Hindrance or  
opposing her such aid and assistance as may be necessary *Provided*  
of Our Dominion, do not bring into the same any of Our Enemies or  
France nor carry on Board any Prohibited or French Goods *Provided*  
any offensive or defensive, Ordnance, Ordnance Stores, Powder Matches  
Iron, Saltpetre, Horses, Saddles, Holsters and other Utensils and Habilitaments  
the Crown of Spain, nor trade in any manner whatsoever for the  
And that this Our Passport shall remain in force for this One  
our Court at *St. James* the One and Twentieth day of March  
Reigne.
